## On the Use of Visitor Parking (Parking Fee)

- 1. This parking lot is for the exclusive use of inpatients / outpatients of this hospital, related persons, and authorized vehicles.
- 2. Please keep the parking ticket you are given at the entrance, as you will need it when leaving.
- 3. The parking fees are as follows

In the case of using the parking lot in front of the entrance, please show a gatekeeper your parking permit.

Note: You can use ONLY \(\frac{1}{2}\)1,000 bills or coins.

- 4. The parking lot is unattended after 8:00 p.m. If you need assistance, please push the call button on the payment machine at the parking lot exit.
- 5. You should pay the parking fee after the medical examinations.

The automatic checkout machines are at the entrance hall and the parking exit.

For congestion relief, please give priority to pay the parking fee at the entrance hall. Thank you for your cooperation.

- 6. Inpatients can use the parking lot only on the day of admission or discharge. Don't use the parking during the hospital stay.
- 7. If you have any questions, please ask the staff at the gate.

Because the days after holidays (especially Mondays) are very crowded, please use public transportation whenever possible.
