## A Guide for Medical Interpreter

Effective communication between patients and our staffs is necessary for providing safe and highquality medical care under our fundamental policies. Medical interpreters help patients who are nonor limited Japanese proficiency. As patients or our staffs need, medical interpreters are arranged by appointment and remunerated on a per-hour basis as follows. We kindly ask for your understanding as they may be unavailable depending on the hours or on languages.
